





2.0 Safety instructions

2.1 Intended use

This toilet is designed for installation in recreation vehicles such as caravans or motorhomes.

2.2 User's responsibility

Anyone operating the sanitation system must be familiar with the safe handling and understand the advice in these operating instructions. Children may only operate the sanitation system if they have been made aware of how to operate it safely and the dangers attending incorrect operation.

2.3 Use of sanitary additives

Before using sanitary means when using and cleaning the toilet, observe the usage notes on the packaging.



CAUTION!

Store these sanitary additives so that they are out of the reach of children.

2.4 Working upon and checking toilet

Leave maintenance and service work to specialist staff.



3.0 Description of model

Model identification 3.1

Example:



The CTS 4110 cassette toilet consists of a toilet which is installed fixed in the vehicle and a removable, mobile cassette as a faeces tank. The cassette can be accessed from the outside through a door. Depending on the model, the toilet receives the flush water from a fresh water tank installed in the vehicle.

■ CTS 4110, free-standing, without water tank, with console

3.2 Toilet identification label

The identification label contains all important details. You can read off from this the model identification, the product number and the serial number. You will need these details whenever you contact the customer services centre or when ordering spare parts. You will find the identification label within the cassette housing after removing the cassette.



3.3 Technical data

3.4 Description of components



- 1 Level indicator / flush (control panel)
- Wall socket console
- **3** Removable seat
- 4 Ceramic toilet bowl
- **(5)** Emptying blade for the toilet bowl
- 6 Housing for cassette tank
- 7 Fresh water tank (option)
- 8 Pour out spout
- 9 Vent button for emptying
- 10 Pull-out handle (cassette tank movable on wheels)
- 11 Service door

4.0 Using the toilet

4.1 Cleaning

Before using the toilet for the first time, we recommend cleaning the toilet on the inside and outside.

Use a soft cloth and lukewarm water with a mild detergent. Then rinse the surfaces with clear water.

CAUTION!

Cleaning agents for the toilet must not contain chlorine or alcohol!



For regular cleaning, Dometic offers "Dometic Quality CARE", an effective toilet cleaning agent from the "Dometic CARE" range (see notes in Section 1.10) which is tailor-made for your toilet's surfaces.

4.2 Preparing cassette tank

Before you use the toilette for the first time:

- Open the service door.
- Unlock the cassette tank by pushing the lock upwards.




Pull the cassette out to the stop and remove it completely.

Place the cassette tank in an upright position and turn the pour out spout upwards by approx. 90°. Remove the cap from the spout.





CAUTION!

Avoid turning the spout by more than 90°, as it may otherwise come loose.

Fill a small amount of a Dometic sanitary additive (see notes in section 1.10) into the cassette tank via the spout.



Put the cassette back in and push it in until it stops.

Ensure that the tank can be smoothly inserted. Do not use force!

- The tank's lock shuts automatically when inserted. But check that the cassette tank is firmly attached.
- Close and lock the service door.

4.3 Filling fresh water tank

Fill the fresh water tank via the filling piece on the outside of the vehicle. The quantity depends on the tank used (on-board tank or integrated toilet tank with models CTW 4xxx, **option** with models **CTS 4xxx** and CTLP 4xxx).



4.4 Control panel



- 1 "Flush" button
- 2 "Cassette tank removed" display
- (3) "Fill fresh water tank" display*
- (4) "Cassette tank 3/4 full" display
- 5 "Cassette tank full" display

^{*} not connected as a rule when using the on-board tank.

4.5 Using the toilet

■ When lifting the toilet seat, it locks in an approximately 2/3 position. Use a little more force if you want to open the seat further.



- Pull the blade handle (2) forwards.
- Leave the blade open during use.



Let some water run into the bowl before use. Operate the flush button (1) for this.



- Operate the flush button (1) again after use to flush the bowl.
- Close the blade handle (2).

4.6 **Emptying the cassette tank**

Empty the cassette tank when the level indicator LED lights up.

The cassette tank has a capacity of 19 I. When LED (4), Fig. 10, lights up, the tank is approx. 80 % full. This means that it can be used only a couple of times.

- Remove the cassette tank as described in section "4.3".
- Carry or wheel the holding tank to the nearest authorized waste disposal point.

The cassette tank is provided with wheels and a pull-out handle. To unlock the handle, push in the button (1) in middle of the handle. Pull out the handle until it stops.



■ To bring the handle back into its original position, press the handle's unlock key and push the handle back into the cassette.

Place the cassette tank in an upright position and turn the emptying spout upwards. Remove the cap from the spout.

CAUTION!

Avoid turning the spout by more than 90°, as it may otherwise come loose.



CAUTION!

Do not shake the cassette tank violently.

Do not clean the inside of the cassette tank with a high pressure cleaner.

This can damage the float for the filling level indicator.



- Hold the cassette tank with one hand by the handle (2). With the other hand hold it at the blade handle (3) so that you can operate the vent button (1) during emptying.
- The vent button should only be pressed once the emptying spout is pointing downwards. The tank empties evenly and without squirting.
- After emptying, flush the cassette tank thoroughly with water. Then make the tank operational again as described in section "4.2", before inserting it in the toilet.

4.7 Exchanging the fuse on the control panel

CAUTION!

Cut off power supply before starting to work!

Lift the control panel with a suitable tool and pull it out of the the tank case or the wall. The fuse (Fig. 19, **automotive fuse : 7.5 A**) is located on the bottom side of the control panel.





4.8 Winter operation

You can continue to use the cassette also in winter, as long as the toilet and the cassette are situated in a frost-protected location.

If this is not the case, empty the fresh water tank, the cassette tank and the water pipes of fresh water supply. This prevents damage due to frost (see "4.9 *Decommissioning*").

CAUTION!

Do not use anti-freeze agents. Such agents can damage the sanitation system.


4.9 Decommissioning

If you wish to decommission the toilet for long periods of time, empty the fresh water tank and the water supply system fully.

- Clean the toilet with Dometic Quality Care.
- Press the flush button until there is no remaining water left in the pipes.
- Then empty the cassette tank and rinse it thoroughly.

To allow the tank to dry, do not place the cap back on the emptying spout of the waste tank.



4.11 Removing the toilet seat






1 = Tool /accessory









4.12 Maintenance

Regularly clean all seals on the toilet and cassette tank.

Carry out this cleaning every month for frequent usage.

Lubricate the seal (1) (Fig. 30) once or twice a year with silicon-based grease or spray. The slide remains movable.



■ grease : OKS[®] 1110

4.12.1 Dismantling the cassette seal

Remove the cassette tank and place it on a solid surface. Dismantle the entire blade, as illustrated in the following images. A seal can now be removed, cleaned or replaced.









4.12.2 Installation of the cassette seal

If it becomes necessary to replace the cassette seal, pay attention to absolutely correct seating of the seal when installing the seal. The seal must contact evenly.





CAUTION!

The seal must contact evenly in the opening otherwise leaks and binding of the blade are possible.



- Close the blade handle.
- Finally, install the support ring.



4.13 Troubleshooting

| Fault | Possible cause | Action you can take |
|------------------------------|--|--|
| Flushing no longer functions | Fuse defective | Replace fuse (see chpt. 4.8) Check electrical terminals and connections in the case of repeated failure |
| Cassette leaking | Seal worn | Replace seal on the blade (see chpt. 4.2.1) |
| No filling level display | Float in the cassette has got stuck or is jammed by toilet paper | Clean float in the cassette (do not use any high-pressure cleaner) |

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
